



# FAENAC<sup>®</sup> : GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

## • RULES TO FOLLOW :

### • Storage :

Vertically, at room temperature, without any local contact (if contact is necessary, the pressure has to be spread over entire surface to avoid any pressure points)

### • Handling:

Carefully using gloves. Can use rubber suction on the inner side (directly on film) if the temperature is < 25°C. Leave the protection on as long as possible (remove it if rubber suction handling on film)

### • Cleaning:

With domestic household aqueous detergent solution (water + alcohol) (commonly available solvents ; ammoniac) with soft clean rags

## • CAUTIONS:

### • Storage :

Do not stock the transparency on it's inner face,  
Do not put anything on the film,  
Sharp objects in contact with the film must be avoided  
Contacts during one minute or more must be avoided when temperature is more than +25°C  
Contact with polystyrene must be avoided.

### • Handling:

Do not use scrapers, razor blades, spatulas, screwdrivers,...

### • Cleaning:

Do not use dry rags, abrasive cleaning solutions. Any other solution but those recommended must be avoided

• Misc. : Beware of stickers that can damage the film during their removal .
